CREATE A NEW SUPERHERO

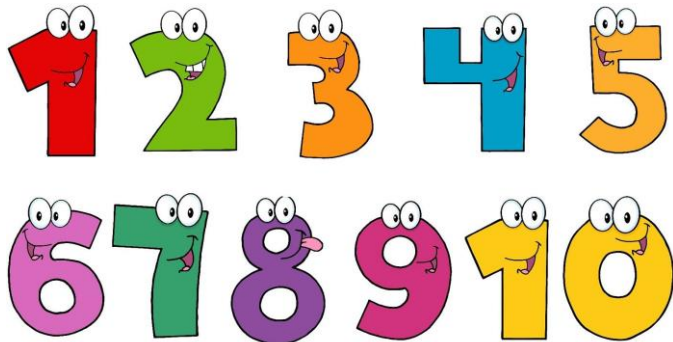
Give them a name and write about their special powers.
