Number Hunt (Numbers 1-10)

Post It Maths - Basic Facts to 10

- Write numbers on a sheet of paper
- Write questions on post it notes or paper with tape (or ask someone to help you write them down)
- Match the question to the correct answer

Make your own chalk! Practicing writing words and letters outside.

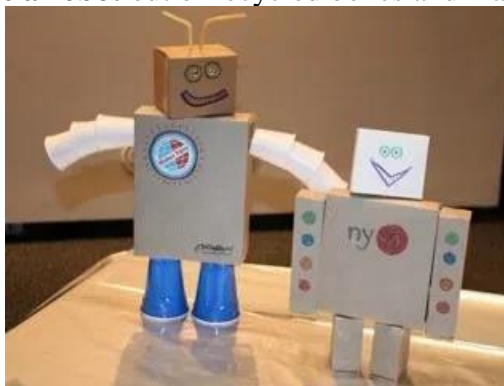


Homemade Sidewalk Chalk!!

Using 2 muffin tins... take 1 1/2 cups cornstarch and 1 1/2 cups water, mix it up and divide it into the 12 muffin cups. Add 2 to 3 drops of food coloring of your choice into each cup and stir. Let harden then pop out and let the kids go crazy!! :)



Equal parts cornflour/cornstarch to water
